The SFAs procedures must note whether an allegation is made verbally or in person. The SFA staff member receiving the allegation must transcribe the complaint. The SFAs procedures for receiving a complaint cannot prevent a complaint from being accepted. Additionally, the SFAs procedures must not indicate that they attempt to resolve the complaint themselves nor can the SFA's complaint process be a prerequisite for accepting a complaint.
