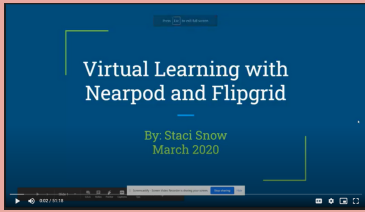

ABE English Language Arts:

Smithsonian For Educators: This site features vetted resources for teachers providing instruction at a distance, as well as virtual tours of ten of the Smithsonian Museums. The resources can be integrated into reading and writing instruction aligned to the **Arizona Adult Education English Language Arts Standards**.

Common Lit: This free site has lots of reading resources for teachers and students! All you need to do is to set up an account. This site is one of the better resources to use for teaching English Language Arts and the curricular resources align to multiple **ELA anchor standards**.

ABE Mathematics:

PBS Targeted Math Instruction for Adult Learners: The 20 lessons were created by Kentucky Adult Education and are designed to help prepare students for the GED Test. This site contains math lessons aligned to the **Arizona Adult Education Mathematics Standards**

English Language Acquisition:

USA Learns: This resource is an approved online curriculum for AZ adult educators-and it's free! In addition to supporting instruction in the four ELAA domains-reading/writing and listening/speaking, the site has recently added a 'Citizenship Course'.

Social Studies and Civics:

iCivics: Created by former Supreme Court Justice, Sandra Day O'Connor, this site has a wealth of resources and lessons for teachers, as well as online activities for students.
