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2 Quantities observed during the review period did Discussed how current system allowed not meet minimum amounts required by the lunch meal pattern: specifically, the weekly oz./eq. grain not met. A PB&J Uncrustable is offered daily crediting as 1 oz./eq. grain. Over the recipes, etc.). Discussed with cafeteria course of the week, only 5 oz./eq. grain offered to students when 8 oz./eq. grain needed to meet weekly minimum amount required by the K-8 lunch meal pattern. This was determined to be a repeat finding from cycle two and contributed towards fiscal action calculations.

This was determined to be a repeat finding from cycle two and contributed towards fiscal action calculations.
