Performance Standard 1: Meal Counting & Claiming- Critical Area

2 Meal count totals by category for the month of review were not correctly combined and recorded. This was deemed a systemic error in the breakfast in the classroom operations.

Discussed how current system allowed that could be made to ensure it doesn't continue.

Changes to the procedures of meal counting and for this to happen and potential changes claiming have been made and a recalculation was conducted. No further corrective action is required at this time.

A full fiscal recalculation of the breakfast program Union Elementary District implemented meal counts was conducted for SY19-20. Due to COVID-19 school closures, 19 days of breakfast counts were collected using the approved counting system for Breakfast in the Classroom.

Fiscal action calculations resulted in a under-

procedures for counting Breakfast in the Classroom meal service using ID cards for each student. Teachers verify that the reimbursable breakfast was served and place those students' ID cards in a zippered pouch. A food service staff claim. Fiscal action calculations were disregarded. member scans the barcodes of the ID cards in the pouches and returns the pouches to the teachers for the next meal service.

5 The verification sample size used was not correct based on the number of applications eligible for verification. Specifically, 10 application should have been verified, but 16 were actually verified.
