State tutor Fund – General	This role is to be assigned to tutors that teach at a school in
User	an LEA. With this role, a tutor can add their students along
	with session time details. Tutors can only see their students
	and sessions.
State tutor Fund –	This role is to be assigned to site coordinators . With this
Coordinator	role, the coordinator will be able to see sessions for all the
	tutors who are assigned within their specific school at one
	time. A coordinator can also be a tutor at their school. This
	role will allow the user to enter students and sessions as a
	tutor and run reports on the other tutors at their school.
	There can only be one coordinator per school site.
State Tutor Fund-Vendor	The role is to be assigned to tutors that are contracted with
User	one of the state tutoring vendor companies . With this role,
	a tutor can add their students along with sessions time
	details. Tutors can only see their students and sessions.
State Tutor Fund- Vendor	The Vendor Admin role will be able to see all of the tutors
Admin	within their company at one time (not individual) who are
	assigned within their company and edit information one at a
	time.
