Performance Standard 2: Meal Components & Quantities- Critical Area

 Portion sizes observed during the month of review did not meet minimum weekly amounts required by the lunch meal pattern. Specifically, on March 2nd and 4th, the Orange Chicken and Chicken Taquitos credited as 1.00 ounce meat/meat alternate equivalents, this resulted in falling 1 ounce equivalent short of meeting weekly minimums.
