Discussed with SFA that the bus route should be its own site and how to add the site in CNP Web.	Please submit a copy of the approved site application demonstrating the bus route has been added. Additionally, please provide written assurance that the sites that are operating will be accurately reflected in CNP Web.
No findings.	Discussed that the classification of site in section 4 of the site application should reflect a church and not a school.	None required.
No findings.	Discussed that the that type of breakfast and lunch service in section 6 of the site application should reflect a satellite kitchen and not a central kitchen.	None required.

	beans/peas).

Discussed that ADE is permitted to provide SSO meal reimbursements when the meal pattern is unable to be met by the SFA providing the meals due to shortages and/or supply chain issues. SFAs must maintain daily records of meals with meal pattern deficiencies by component, per meal service. To support the claim for reimbursement of meals, the SFA is required to provide a meal pattern waiver request form to ADE.

Please submit a waiver to ADE for each occurrence where the meal pattern was not met. Additionally, please provide written assurance that if the meal pattern cannot be adhered to for all meal services at all times, a waiver will be submitted to ADE.
