

CERTIFICATION GUIDELINES FOR TEACHING ASSIGNMENTS



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Introduction

A.R.S. § 15-203 authorizes the State Board to supervise and control the certification of educators, and to exercise general supervision over and regulate the conduct of the public-school system. The provisions in Board of Education rule R7-2-607(W) establish that the required certificate, approved area, or endorsement for teaching positions shall be established in this Certification Guidelines for Teaching Assignments.

Arizona school districts should use the *Certification Guidelines for Teaching Assignments* to determine if a teacher is appropriately certified for an assignment. Per Arizona Revised Statutes § 15-183(C)(5), teachers in charter schools are not required to be certified unless they are assigned to a special education position.

Glossary of Terms

For the purposes of this document, the following definitions apply:

“Appropriately Certified” means holding the Certificate, Endorsement and Approved Area that is required for a teaching assignment.

“Approved Area” means a subject area denoted on a teaching certificate that is taught in Arizona public schools.

“Certificate” means one of the following Arizona teaching certificate types which, when combined with the appropriate certification area, approved area, and/or endorsement, may be used to meet appropriately certified requirements:

- Alternative Teaching
- Classroom-Based Standard Teaching
- International Teaching
- JROTC
- Native American Language
- Specialized Secondary STEM
- Standard Career and Technical Education (CTE)
- Standard Specialized CTE
- Standard Professional Teaching
- Student Teaching Intern
- Subject Matter Expert Standard Teaching

“Endorsement” means an attachment to a teaching certificate which provides an additional authorization to the holder.

“IEP” means Individualized Education Program. The IEP is a legal document mandated by the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) that defines the individualized goals of a child who has been found to have a disability, as defined by federal regulations. [20 U.S.C. 1401 and 1412; A.R.S. § 15-761(11)]

“Literacy Instruction” means instruction in English language arts provided by a teacher.

“Primary teaching assignment” means the subject area that a teacher is assigned to for the greater part of their instructional schedule. For teachers who are assigned to two or more subjects in equal parts of their instructional schedule, the “primary teaching assignment” refers to each subject.

“Structured English Immersion (SEI) Classroom” means a classroom in which one or more English learners is receiving Targeted and/or Integrated English Language Development (ELD) Instruction.

“Self-contained classroom” means a classroom in which the teacher teaches multiple subjects to one class of students. Note: This definition applies to Arizona Certification rules and does not apply to the same term used under the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA).

“Single subject classroom” means a classroom in which the teacher teaches one subject to one class of students.

“World language”: Means a world language other than English.

Kindergarten-Grade 8: Self-Contained Classroom

The table below provides the appropriately certified requirements for teachers who teach the core subjects of language arts, mathematics, science, and social studies in a self-contained, K-8 classroom.

¹ Individuals who receive a teaching certificate in early childhood education, elementary education, middle grades education, or special education before August 1, 2025, are required to obtain a Literacy, K-5 endorsement or a Reading Specialist, K-8 or K-12 by **August 1, 2028**, if they are providing literacy instruction to students in kindergarten through grade five. Teachers who are certified **after** August 1, 2025, will be required to obtain the endorsement within three years of certificate issuance.

Special Education Teaching Assignments, Birth-Grade 12

Glossary of Terms: Special Education Teaching Assignments

Hearing Impaired: An assignment as a special education teacher providing services to students who are deaf or hard of hearing.

Special Education Early Childhood: An assignment as a special education teacher providing services to students in birth through grade three who have been identified with one or more of the following disability categories: autism, developmental disability, emotional disability, mild intellectual disability, moderate intellectual disability, severe intellectual disability, orthopedic impairment, other health impairment, preschool severe delay, specific learning disability and/or traumatic brain injury.

Special Education Mild/Moderate Disabilities: An assignment as a special education teacher providing services to students who have been identified with one or more of the following disability categories: mild/moderate autism, developmental disability, emotional disability, mild intellectual disability, moderate intellectual disability, orthopedic impairment, other health impairment, specific learning disability and/or traumatic brain injury.

Special Education Moderate/Severe Disabilities: An assignment as a special education teacher providing services to students who have been identified with one or more of the following disability categories: autism, moderate intellectual disabilities, severe intellectual disabilities, traumatic brain injury, emotional disability, orthopedic impairments, and/or other health impairments.

Visually Impaired: An assignment as a special education teacher providing services to students who are blind or have visual impairments.

Additional Requirements for Special Education Teachers

In addition to the appropriately certified requirements described in this section, special education teachers must hold the same endorsement and/or approved area required for a general education teacher. Specifically:

- **English learners:** Special education teachers who have one or more English learners receiving Targeted and/or Integrated English Language Development (ELD) Instruction are required to hold a Provisional or full SEI endorsement, a Provisional or full ESL endorsement, or a full Bilingual endorsement.
- **Single Subject, Grades 6-12:** A special education teacher assigned to a single subject, grades six through twelve classroom must hold an approved area or endorsement in the primary subject area(s) that they teach.
- **Literacy instruction in K-5:** A special education teacher who provides literacy instruction to students in kindergarten through grade five must obtain one of the following **within three years** of certificate issuance:
 - Literacy, K-5 Endorsement
 - Reading Specialist K-8 Endorsement
 - Reading Specialist, K-12 Endorsement¹⁰

¹⁰ Individuals who receive a teaching certificate in early childhood education, elementary education, middle grades education, or special education before August 1, 2025, are required to obtain a Literacy, K-5 endorsement or a Reading Specialist, K-8 or K-12 by **August 1, 2028**, if they are providing English language arts instruction to students in kindergarten through grade five. Teachers who are certified **after** August 1, 2025, will be required to obtain the endorsement within three years of certificate issuance. The local school district will be responsible for ensuring teachers who provide English language arts instruction obtain the endorsement within the three-year timeframe.
