

AASA Parent Portal User Guide

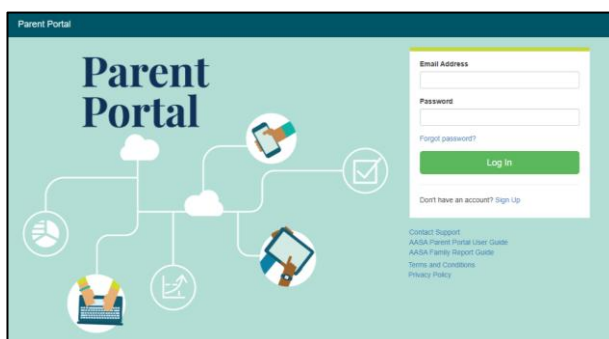

The Arizona's Academic Standards Assessment (AASA) Parent Portal is an **optional** resource available to participating schools and families. It allows families to securely access their student's *AASA Confidential Student Score Report* online using the student's first name, last name, date of birth, and a claim code. The claim code can only be provided by the student's school or district. **Your student's claim code is provided at the top of this guide.**

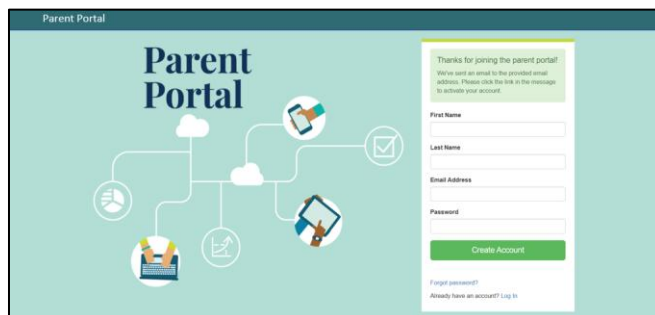
After creating a user account on the AASA Parent Portal, families will enter the student's information to retrieve the *AASA Confidential Student Score Report* (Individual Student Report). Families that have an existing AASA Parent Portal user account from previous years can use their same login information (email address and password) to log into their account and access their student's report. A password reset can be performed by clicking on the **Forgot password?** link on the AASA Parent Portal home screen (<https://az-results.pearsonaccessnext.com/login>).

To create a new Parent Portal user account and access your student's report, follow these steps. If you have an existing AASA Parent Portal user account, skip to **Step 4** of these directions.

1. Go to the AASA Parent Portal home screen at <https://az-results.pearsonaccessnext.com/login>, and create a user account by clicking on the **Sign Up** link located below the green **Log In** button.



2. The portal will ask for your **First Name**, **Last Name**, **Email Address**, and **Password**. Once the information has been entered, click on the green **Create Account** button. The portal will send an activation email to the email address you provided. Look for this email and click on the activation link to finish creating your account.



- Once your account has been created and you click the activation link provided in the automated email, you will be routed back to the AASA Parent Portal home screen (refer to the screen image shown in **Step 1**).
- On the AASA Parent Portal home screen (<https://az-results.pearsonaccessnext.com/login>), enter your **Email Address** and **Password**. Then, click the green **Log In** button.
- You will be routed to the **Test Results** screen. On the left side of this screen, in the **Find Test Results** section, enter the **Student's First Name**, **Student's Last Name**, **Student's Date of Birth**, and **Claim Code**. Then, click on the green **Find Results** button. **Note:** Your student's information must match their unique AASA testing registration information. Contact your student's school if the information entered results in any unexpected errors.

- The AASA Parent Portal will retrieve your student's *AASA Confidential Student Score Report* (Individual Student Report). On the right side of the screen, the Math and ELA (English Language Arts) results will be displayed. The **Download Individual Student Report** link will allow you to open and/or download a PDF copy of your student's *AASA Confidential Student Score Report* for the corresponding grade level and content area. If you have accessed prior year AASA test results for your student in the portal, these test results will also appear with the test administration year included in the report name.

Note: The AASA Parent Portal screen with test results is being provided as a sample only. The student's test results information may slightly vary.
