




Implications

Having a single activity form shifts some of the burden of time and effort in pursuing systemic change from documenting initiatives to pursuing them. It allows the SSIP Teams to reference within, rather than between, documents.

80% of respondents reported their SSIP Tracking form and correspondence with their ESS Specialist as being helpful resources during SSIP.

96% reported that their SSIP Teams meets either monthly or quarterly to discuss SSIP Progress in their learning communities.


While most reported SSIP resources positively, 29% would like more guidance, support, and collaboration including onsite visits when possible.






SSIP Survey Question—Rating Outcomes
