Review procedures, timelines, communication strategies, and examples of successful implementation.

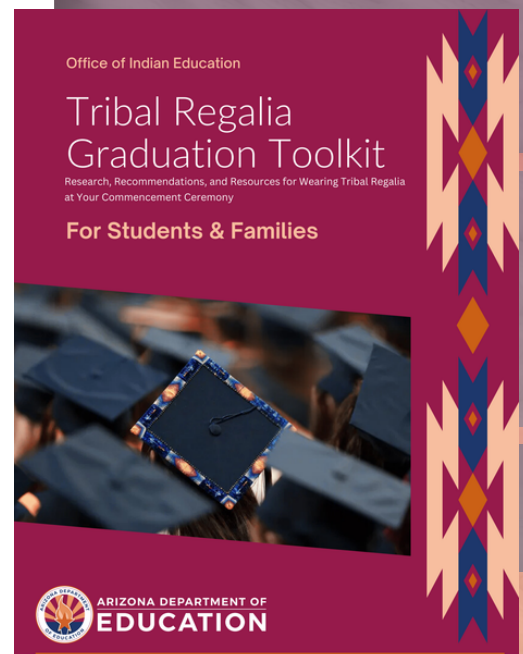
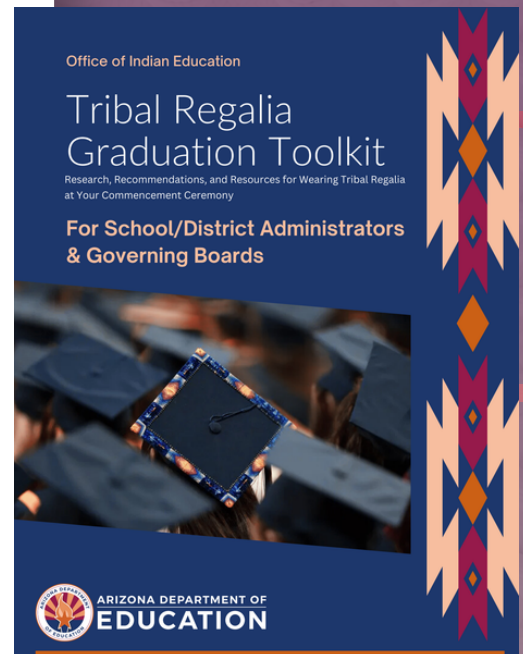
