2	A. School districts and charter schools in this state may choose to participate in the State Seal
3	of Arts Proficiency Program which recognizes students who have attained a high level of
4	proficiency in the Arts. School districts and charter schools participating in the Program may award
5	the State Seal of Arts Proficiency to any high school student who graduates from a school operated
6	by the school district or charter school and who meets the requirements of the Program outlined in
7	subsections (1) and (2). To be eligible, a student shall do both of the following:
8	1. Complete all qualifying Arts and Career and Technical Education (CTE) courses
9	with GPA of 3.0 or better on a 4.0 scale, or the equivalent.
10	2. Complete the required activities from each of the following 3 categories:
11	a. Minimum Credit Requirements. The student shall complete the required
12	number of Arts and CTE classes as follows:
13	i. A minimum of 4 credits in one artistic discipline;
14	ii. 3 credits in one artistic discipline, and 1 qualifying creative
15	industries CTE credit or separate artistic discipline; or
16	iii. 2 credits in one artistic discipline, and 2 credits in a qualifying
17	creative industries CTE credits or separate artistic discipline.
18	b. Arts related extracurricular activities. The student shall complete the
19	required number of hours engaged in arts related extracurricular activity for purposes of
20	demonstrating arts proficiency as follows:
21	i. Students graduating in school year 2019-2020 must complete at
22	least 30 hours engaged in arts related extracurricular activities as
23	identified by the school district or charter school.

24	ii. <u>St</u>	udents graduating in school year 2020-2021 must complete at
25	<u>lea</u>	ast 45 hours engaged in arts related extracurricular activities as
26	<u>ide</u>	entified by the school district or charter school.
27	iii. <u>St</u>	udents graduating in school year 2021-2022 must complete at

37	of Arts Proficiency available to	each school district or charter school participating in the Program.
