All artwork must be original design. Computer-generated images and traced images will not be judged. It is critical that submitted artwork not be overly derivative of images found on the Internet, in print media or elsewhere.

Submitted artwork images may be photographed and become property of the Sonoran Arts League. Artwork may be used in promotional material, with appropriate credit to the student artists wherever possible. Please do not send in original artwork. Submissions are all online. Please take high res or professional photographs of your artwork.

HOW TO ENTER

Follow directions carefully and provide all information requested on the online registration. **You must submit your artwork by September 20, 2020.** Late entries will not be judged.

- Step 2:** Photograph your artwork (it is recommended a high res image of your artwork be submitted or semi professional photograph of your artwork.
